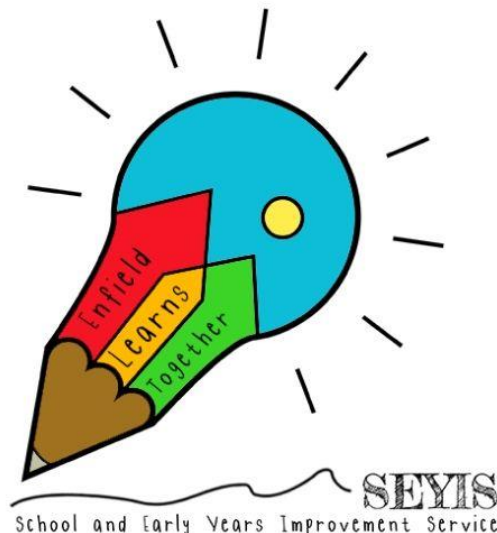

Enfield Learns Together Short Story Competition

Information for applicants

Categories:	Year 1 Year 2 Years 3-4 Years 5-6 Years 7-8
Prizes:	There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize for each category
Competition entries:	Each Enfield young author can enter one short story
Short Story for years 1-4	Pupils in years 1-4 are invited to enter a hand-written story that addresses the theme of "COMMUNITY". The story should be a maximum of 2 sides of A4 and entries should be photographed and submitted with a completed application form Please note that the judges will only accept handwritten stories. Competition entries must be independent and unaided work written by the child entering the competition. The final written piece should not be marked or amended by a teacher or parent. Please be aware that all shortlisted published stories will be sent to Enfield Primary and Secondary Schools and will therefore be read by young children. Judges reserve the right to not publish stories that they feel are inappropriate for young children.
Short Story for years 5-8	Entries should be a short story addressing the theme of 'COMMUNITY', a maximum of 500 words in length and written in Word. Competition entries must be independent and unaided work written by the child entering the competition. The final written piece should not be marked or amended by a teacher, parent or carer. Please be aware that all shortlisted published stories will be sent to Enfield Primary and Secondary Schools and will therefore be read by young children. Judges reserve the right to not publish stories that they feel are inappropriate for young children.
Criteria:	The judging criteria are attached
Judging:	Short listing and judging will be carried out by a panel of colleagues from Enfield School and Early Years' Service and an external judge

Application Deadline:	Applications for the Enfield Learns Together Short Story Competition should be submitted no later than 1pm on Friday 5 June 2020. Entries for years 1-4 should be photographed and emailed to enrichment@enfield.gov.uk with a completed application form. Please ensure that the photograph file name includes the name of the child. Entries for years 5-8 should be word documents and should be emailed to enrichment@enfield.gov.uk with a completed application form.
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
