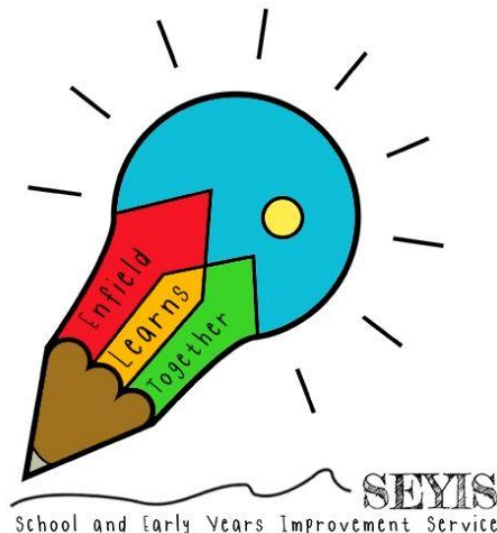

Challenge 5

Write a Pi Poem or Story

Suggested age range: 7-14

A pi poem or story is made up of words with the same number of letters as in each digit of pi (3.14159,,,,,) So your poem or story should start with a 3-letter word, then a 1-letter word, then a 4-letter word and so on. Try writing a poem or story using the digits in pi to 20 decimal places. The link below will take you to a chart that will help you record and organise your words.
