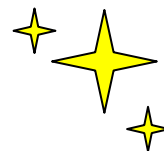
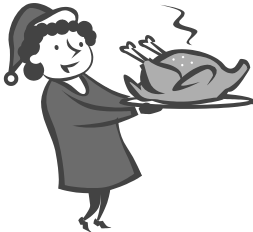


Christmas 2020 at St John & St James CofE Primary School
